Keywords: Alphabetically sorted; Capitalized first word; Consists of 4-6 phrases; Sentence case; Separate by comma (,) or semicolon (;) between keywords

Introduction

Provide an adequate background, context of the problems, and purpose of the research, hypothesis and literature review. The literature review consists of results or review from the previous researches. Sub heading is not allow in the Introduction.

This guidelines is used in Jurnal Transportasi Multimodal template. The template are using Microsoft Word, Times New Romans, 11 pt, and spasi 1 with 6 pt after indent. The paper should be in Bahasa Indonesia or English. The authors who are not using their mother language should check their paper to native speaker (or as a 2nd author) before submit the paper. Literature cited can use *Chicago Manual Style (CMS)* and *references manager application* such as: *Mendeley, Zotero, Endnotes*, dll.

Methods

Provide sufficient detail methods to allow work to be reproduced such as the research location, time, type of research, data collecting method, and analysis method. In this section, the sub heading are allow by using the **(Heading)** template.

Result and Discussion

Result should be clear and concise. Discussion must explore the significance of the results of the research and not a reduplication or repetition. The picture and illustration should be in the best quality. In this section are allow to display sub heading by using (**Heading**) template.

Conclusion

Conclusion section should not repeating results from discussion and is not a summary of the research but a brief explanation in full sentences or in the form of conclusions in sequence. The conclusion should answer the research questions and problems. The triangle consistency (problems- purposes- conclusion) must be achieved for check and re-check. If needed the recommendation are allow to be included which contain academic recommendation, follow up action or the policy implications. It is not permissible to make sub heading in this section.

Acknowledgement

Provide acknowledgements for those individuals or institutions provided help during the research (e.g providing grants, institution, laboratory facility, language help, writing assisence, etc)

References

Literature cited can use *Chicago Manual Style* (CMS) and *references manager application* such as: *Mendeley, Zotero, Endnotes*, dll. The number of Literature references at least 80% from the primary reference source for publication (journals/proceeding) issued at least the last 10 years. The references can be divided into 2 types such as non-electronic sources and electronic sources.

Author, "Title". Company, City, State or Country, Tech. Rep. number, month, year.

Heading Level 1

Should written in: *Capitalized each words*, align text left, **bold**, font TNR 12pt, spasi 1.

Heading Level 2

Should written in: *Capitalized each words*, align text left, **bold**, font TNR 12pt, spasi

Heading level 3

Should written in: *Sentence case*, align text left, *Italic*, font TNR 12pt, spasi 1.

Heading level 4

Not Acceptable

Table Title is placed above the table by using font TNR 9 pt. The word “Table” should be **bold** while the table title written normally (*Sentence case*). The numbering of the table titles are using Arabic numbering (1, 2, 3, etc.). Content of tables are using font TNR 9 pt with spasi 1. The sources or information notation is placed under the table, align text left, *italics*, written by using TNR 8pt.

Figure can be graphics, matrices, photos, diagrams, etc and placed in the center of the page (*centered*). The title of the images is written below in the figure, using the font TNR 9pt. The word “Pictures” and “Numbers” are written using **bold** font by using Arabic numbering (1, 2, 3, etc.), while the contents

are written using the *Sentence case*. The sources or information notation is placed under the figure title, align text left, *italics*, written by using TNR 8pt. The images should be in *file .jpg, .jpeg, atau .tif* format with black or white color except the colour has certain meanings with the resolution at least 300 dpi.

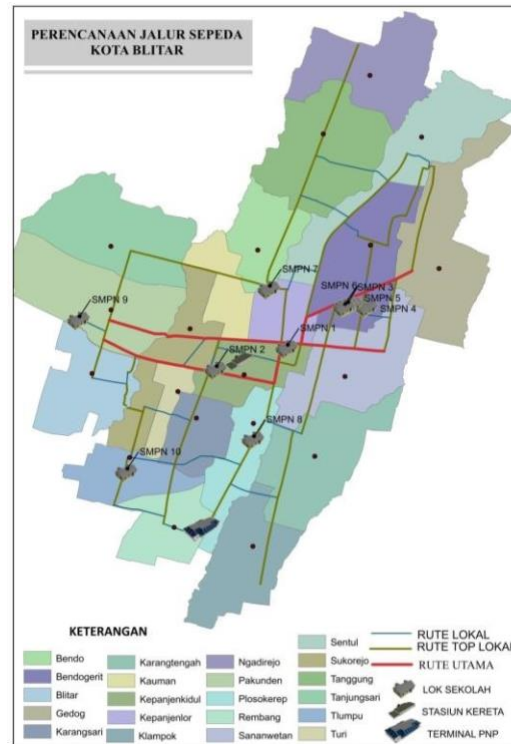


Figure 1. Perencanaan Jalur Sepeda Berdasarkan Pembagian Rute.

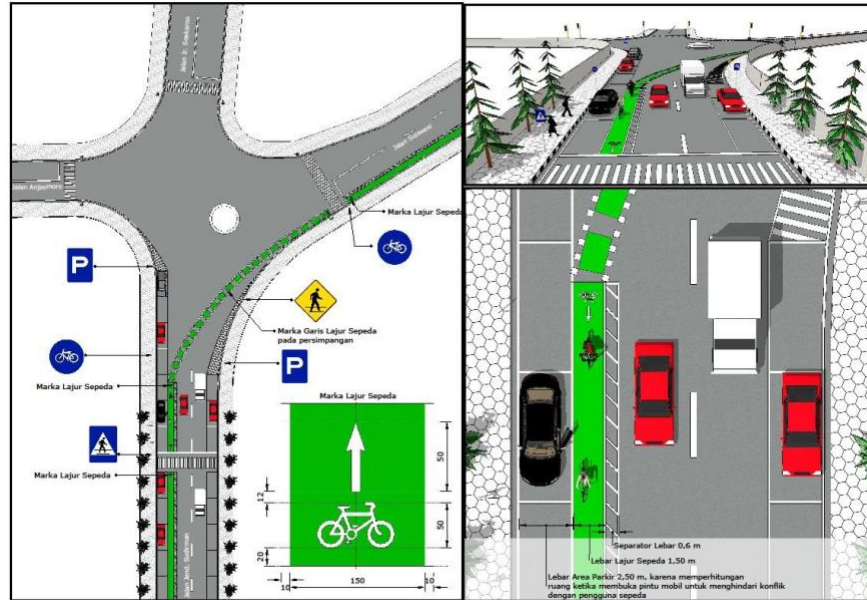


Figure 1. Desain Jalur Sepeda di Jalan Sudirman.
